CALL TO ORDER: A Regular Meeting of the Council of the Borough of Elmer convened in the Borough Hall at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Joseph Stemberger presiding.

FLAG SALUTE AND INVOCATION: The pledge of allegiance was given by Mayor Stemberger followed by the invocation. Mayor Stemberger noted that adequate notice of the meeting was provided on January 14, 2021 pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act.

ROLL CALL: Council President Lewis Schneider, Council Members Lynda Davis, Bruce Foster, Steven Schalick, James Zee, and Mayor Joseph Stemberger answered to the roll call. Absent was Council Member Cynthia Nolan. Also present were Solicitor Brian Duffield, Chief Financial Officer Cynthia Strang, and Clerk Sarah Walker.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Motion Davis second Foster to approve the minutes from the Regular Council Meeting held on July 14, 2021, and to dispense with the reading of the minutes.

PUBLIC SESSION: Motion Zee second Foster to open the public portion of the meeting. All were in favor and the motion carried. There being no members of the public present, motion Davis second Foster to close the public portion of the meeting. All were in favor and motion carried.

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMER, COUNTY OF SALEM, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AWARDING CONTRACT TO ARAWAK PAVING CO. FOR THE RESURFACING OF 2ND, 3RD, AND OAK STREETS

WHEREAS, the Borough Council authorized advertisement and solicitation of Requests for Proposals ("Proposals") for the resurfacing of 2nd, 3rd, and Oak Streets, and

WHEREAS, Proposals were received and opened on August 4, 2021, at 10:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, five (5) proposals were received from the following entities:

- 1. Arawak Paving Co.
- 2. South State, Inc.
- 3. Paving Plus LLC
- 4. Think Pavers
- 5. Charles Marandino LLC

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has reviewed the recommendations made by the Borough's Engineer, Consulting Engineer Services, via correspondence dated August 9, 2021, (attached) on said bids; and

WHEREAS, Arawak Paving Co., Inc. submitted the lowest bid in the sum of \$199,400.00 for Base Bid and Alternate Bid No. 1; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Arawak Paving Co., Inc. is the lowest monetary responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's Engineer has determined that the bid is in conformance with the Bid Specifications, and recommends the award of the Contract to Arawak Paving Co., Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to award the Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmer that the Contract for the resurfacing of 2nd, 3rd, and Oak Streets, be and the same is hereby awarded to Arawak Paving Co., Inc. on its bid in the sum of \$199,400.00 for the Base Bid and Alternate Bid No. 1, subject to the conditions set forth below.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk of the Borough of Elmer are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Contract for same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Contract award is contingent upon NJDOT approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the certified checks or bid bonds of the successful bidder and next lowest bidder are to be returned upon the receipt of fully executed Contract and other required documents by the lowest bidder, Arawak Paving Co., Inc.

Motion Davis second Foster to adopt Resolution 70-21.

Motion Davis second Zee that the Clerk and Mayor's correspondence be received and filed. All were in favor and motion carried.

Finance/Celebration Public Events: Schalick discussed Harvest Day reimbursements.

Public Safety: Schneider provided the police report.

Streets/Sidewalks: Foster noted that he represented the Borough at the Salem County Fair at the County Stormwater booth.

Borough Hall/Public Property: Council members reviewed the color options for the new ramp canopy for the ADA project and chose forest green.

Water/Street Lights/IT: Zee provided the water report including the results of the required lead sampling, updated Council on meetings regarding the American Legion Ambulance service, and reported on the progress of the activities to control the feral cat population.

Trash/Recycling/Parks & Playgrounds: No report.

ONGOING PROJECTS:

Green Acres Park: Schneider mentioned that he will be getting a price from the Borough Engineer CES on building a pickleball court at the new park.
